The School will aim to:

- Provide a broad and balanced education suitable to each student's ability.

- Set and mark promptly homework tasks and send home regular reports on your child's progress in all areas of the curriculum.
- Ensure that clear communication with parents / carers is maintained; including meetings and
 events to inform you of any matters that could affect your child's work, behaviour or happiness
 in school.
- Encourage parental involvement in the work and life of our school.

Parents / Carers will aim to:

- Make sure that their child attends school on time in uniform and properly equipped with books and materials for all lessons.
- Let the school know of any matters that could affect their child's work or behaviour at school alongside working collaboratively with the school by supporting its policies and guidelines, including those centred on behaviour, equal opportunities, uniform and equipment.
- Ensure that their child completes the homework set, including signing planners on a weekly hasis
- Attend parents' evenings and other meetings to discuss and support their child's progress in school.
- Ensure that their child participates in at least one extra-curricular activity.

Each Student will aim to:

- Attend school every day, get to lessons on time and bring all the equipment needed for the
 activities of the day.
- Wear the school uniform, be tidy in appearance and keep the school environment clean and free from litter and graffiti.
- Be actively engaged in all lessons, listen to teacher instructions and do all class work and homework effectively.
