Home and School Partnership Agreement

The School will aim to:

- Provide a broad and balanced education suitable to each student's ability.

- Encourage parental involvement in the work and life of our school.

Parents / Carers will aim to:

- Make sure that their child attends school on time, in uniform and properly equipped with books and materials for all lessons.
- Let the school know of any matters that could affect their child's work or behaviour at school alongside working collaboratively with the school by supporting its policies and guidelines, including those centred on behaviour, equal opportunities, uniform and equipment. These policies are available on the school website.
- Monitor the completion of homework, ensuring it is done to a high standard and submitted on time.
- Attend parents' evenings and other meetings to discuss and support their child's progress in school.
- Ensure that their child participates in at least one extra-curricular activity.
- Ensure that communications from the school that require a response are either acknowledged or replied to.
- Notify the attendance office if their child will not be attending school that day for any reason.

Each Student will aim to:

- Attend school every day, get to lessons on time and bring all the equipment needed for the activities of the day.
- Wear the school uniform, be tidy in appearance and keep the school environment clean and free from litter and graffiti.
- Be actively engaged in all lessons, listen to teacher instructions and complete all class work and homework to the best of their ability.
- Be polite and respectful to all the individuals from our school community

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and support the school's policy of being a 'telling school' by working collaboratively to resolve any difficulties that may arise.
