

## Summer school 2021

In July 2021 Grey Court ran a summer school as part of the government's Covid catch up response, in line with Department for Education guidance.

This was run over five days from 26th to 30th July 2021 inclusive.

The opportunity to attend was given to every one of the 2021-22 current year 7 cohort. Simultaneously, 233 pupils in the 2021-22 year 11 cohort were given the opportunity to catch up with some of their disrupted GCSE learning.

Not all pupils attended and those that did, did not necessarily attend every day. 204 pupils from year 7 attended for one or more day(s). 45 pupils from year 11 attended for one or more day(s). 31 pupils across both of these years were eligible for pupil premium funding. In total, 1,021 pupil days were delivered.

The costs (ex VAT) incurred in delivering the summer school were as follows:

Staffing: £21,608.65

Catering: £5,269.50

Third party activities: £3,854

Equipment: £25,862.50\*

Miscellaneous; £1,350\*\* (cleaning/photocopying etc).

\*Equipment included art and maths packs (incorporating scientific calculators) given to every year 7 pupil as well as literature gifted to each student. Other equipment, ranged from T-shirts and spray paints for T-shirt graffiti to lino cutters and tiles as well as learning support resources such as dyslexic overlays and primary school maths and English resources to help those students requiring a little more support in their transition to secondary school.

\*\* miscellaneous costs included photocopying and covid-compliant cleaning.

All students, regardless of their academic year, were given a maths and English session each day. For those in year 7, the remainder of lessons were split between PE, art, music, dance, drama, team building, inflatable fun, computing

and ice breakers. The week culminated in a show with each class taking turns to perform to the remainder of their year group.

For pupils in year 11, a more academic week was tempered by daily PE/activity sessions and the opportunity to take part in an “It's a Knockout” inflatable challenge.
